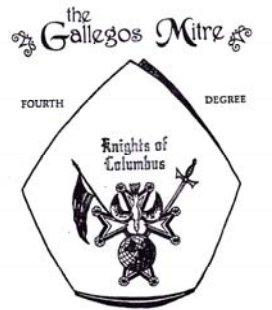

## **Thoughts on Memorial Day**

Once again, our distinguished Color Corps represented the Assembly at the Memorial Day remembrance in Galt. Memorial Day as it is focuses on those who have served (past tense) our country as patriots. It is right that we take part in this as the patriotic arm of our order. But we should also remember those who are currently serving. Perhaps the best way to do so, other than remembering them in our prayers, is to send those serving overseas items that they are not supplied with as a part of standard military equipment.

In that regard, at our June meeting we will collect items to ship to our troops overseas. SK Niel Evans in conjunction with others is active in sending items to troops overseas. We will turn the items over to Niel for inclusion with the next shipment. The items needed/requested by our fighting men and women include:

Non-perishable food items: single size servings of canned fruit, instant oatmeal, instant hot chocolate and coffee creamer. Some of the most requested items in this category are: granola bars, energy bars, single-size drink mix packets like crystal light or kool aid powders, and beef jerky, slim jims, sausage sticks.

Our troops also request a variety of personal hygiene items. These include the small plastic hotel or travel sized bottles of shampoo, toothpaste, hand lotion, sunscreen, pain relievers (Tylenol, advil), chapstick, and baby wipes. Our female troops also need feminine hygiene products like panty liners.

Lastly, they also like entertainment items like music CDs, movies (DVDs), crossword puzzles or other kinds of puzzle magazines, playing cards, batteries, writing paper, pens, and size double A batteries. We ask that you do not bring books as they are heavy and it costs more to ship them overseas.

Finally, there is the cost of shipping. If you don't/can't do a little shopping, bring some cash to help ship these items to our patriotic fighting men and women.

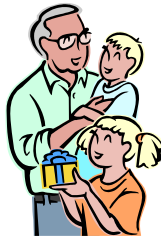
